## **Priority Science Prerequisite Courses**

- \*\*If applying to Fall 2025 Admissions, the 3 courses must be completed by the end of Fall Semester 2024
- \*\*If applying to Fall 2026 Admissions, the 3 courses must be completed by the end of Fall Semester 2025
