## **Priority Science Prerequisite Courses**

These courses must be completed or in process at the time of application:

- \*\*If applying to Fall 2024 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2023
- \*\*If applying to Fall 2025 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2024
- \*\*If applying to Fall 2026 Admissions, the 5 courses must be completed by the end of Winter Quarter 2025
