## For admissions eligibility:

- Students must have a 3.0 minimum cumulative GPA in the EWU Nursing prerequisite courses.
- Students must have a 3.0 cumulative GPA in all college level coursework from all schools attended.
- Minimum of 2.0 GPA in any course taken.
- A&P series is required to be taken at the same institution for continuity.
- Chemistry series is required to be taken at the same institution for continuity.
