

EWU School of Social Work - MSW Advanced Standing Program Full-Time Advanced Standing Course of Study

The 51-credit advanced standing program for full-time students provides qualified BSW/BASW graduates a waiver for the MSW foundation content. Advanced standing students begin their studies with a summer advanced standing seminar and then join a current cohort of students to complete the MSW advanced generalist curriculum. In-person classes are offered at the Catalyst building in Spokane, except for the summer seminar.
