

Spokane Part-Time MSW Program | Draft 2025 – 2028 Cohort Schedule (Course schedule and weekend dates are subject to change)

The EWU Spokane PT Master of Social Work Program is tailored to individuals who would otherwise be unable to attend courses on a full-time basis. Students will take between four to nine credits per quarter to complete the program in three years.

Required core courses use a hybrid format with in-person classes held on three weekends each quarter, and online modules the remaining weeks of the quarter. The in-person classes generally fall on the 1st, 5th, and 10th weekends of each quarter, except the 8-week summer sessions which fall on the 1st or 2nd, 4th, and 7th weekends. Elective courses are offered fully online, in person, or in a hybrid format. Orientation will take place in person prior to the first weekend of classes.
