The EWU Spokane PT Master of Social Work Program is tailored to individuals who would otherwise be unable to attend courses full-time. Advanced-standing students will join the 2025 – 2028 cohort in the summer of 2026 and will complete the program in eight quarters. Students will take between four and eight credits each quarter.

Required core courses use a hybrid format, with in-person classes held on three weekends each quarter and online modules for the remaining weeks. Students must be able to commit to attending the required in-person weekends. The in-person classes generally fall on the 1st, 5th, and 10th weekends of each quarter, except for the 8-week summer sessions, which fall on the 1st or 2nd, 4th, and 7th weekends. Elective courses are offered fully online, in person, or in a hybrid format. Orientation will take place during the summer 2026 seminar.

Estimated Tuition Rates
