

Bringing in the Research Grant Awards!

National Institutes of Health Support for Research Excellence (R16) Program awarded **Dr. Jason Ashley** over \$480,000 for materials/supplies, faculty time, graduate students, and undergraduate research assistants in addition to conference travel. From Dr. Ashley; "This project seeks to expand understanding of how decoration of **Notch signaling receptors** with sugars influences the formation and function of osteoclasts, bone-dissolving cells. Completion of this work will contribute to knowledge of Notch signaling regulatory mechanisms. In the longer term, better understanding of this phenomenon may lead to new therapies based on finer control of these cells to prevent bone loss." Congratulations Dr. Ashley and Kristyl!

Congratulations to **Dr. Robin O'Quinn** (Biology) and to her Master's student, **Katherine Cole,** on receiving a research grant from the Stuntz Mycology Fund! The award is \$3,300 for the project, "Understanding the Diversity and Distribution of **Arbuscular Mycorrhizal Fungi** Across Land-Use Types on Prairie Ecosystems of the Inland Pacific Northwest." The funds will support research efforts at the EWU Prairie Restoration Project and, through collaboration with local landowners who are giving permission for sampling on their properties, will help EWU increase its engagement with this region.

Dr. Jessica Allen and graduate student **Julianna Paulsen** were awarded \$3,300 from the Stuntz Mycology Foundation for the project, "Revitalizing the **Eastern Washington University Herbarium**: Expanding Opportunities for Undergraduate Research, Experiential Learning, and Research-Infused Curriculum." The funds will support the digitization of over a thousand specimens, which will make these specimens available for teaching and research, provide students with professional development skills, develop classroom activities, and create a website to increase the visibility of the EWU Herbarium and promote collaboration with others. Congratulations on writing a competitive proposal that will fund this investment in EWU's facilities and students.


