Valuation under \$5,000:

- The donor must complete an In-Kind Agreement form including an itemized, detailed description and dollar value for each item.
- The foundation accepts the donor's valuation of the gift(s), provided it appears to be reasonable.
 The donor should submit receipt copies, price lists from catalogs, internet or other sources for comparable items to assist in determining reasonable value for EWU Foundation recognition purposes (which is separate from what the donor needs for IRS purposes).
- Both the donor and foundation representative must sign and date the document. The foundation representative's signature on the In-Kind Agreement form is an acknowledgement of receipt of the gift(s) and not agreement with the valuation of the gift(s).

Valuation over \$5,000 (other than publicly traded securities):

- The donor must obtain a written appraisal of the gift(s) from a qualified appraiser.
- A copy of the appraisal must be sent to the EWU Foundation for insurance coverage purposes.
- The donor must complete an In-Kind Gift Agreement form including an itemized, detailed description and dollar value for each item.
- The donor and foundation representative must sign and date the document.
- If the donor chooses to complete an IRS Form 8283 "Noncash Charitable Contributions Appraisal Summary," the Director of Financial Services from the foundation will sign Part 1 certifying acceptance of the gift.
- If the foundation sells the gift(s) within two years after receiving it, a Form 8282 "Donee Information Return" must be filed with the IRS, by the foundation, within 90 days after the sale. A copy of the Form 8282 will be sent to the donor, as well as with the IRS.
