I hope this message finds you well and enjoying the summer season. We are excited to welcome three new members, Gordon Hester, Brian Paige and Travis Simpson to the Foundation Board!

President McMahan recently announced a new leadership structure within University Advancement. In July, she appointed Eric Limburg and me to co-lead the division for the time being. Eric's portfolio includes marketing, communications and alumni relations. You will find a short biography for Eric in this newsletter. My role encompasses fundraising and advancement services, and I am acting as the executive director of the EWU Foundation.

After a 30-year curatorial and administrative museum career, the Great Recession taught me that strong museums needed strong fundraising programs. Because universities are the sector of the American fundraising demonstrating the most consistent practices and success. I was excited to come to Eastern in 2013 as stewardship coordinator seeking a way to learn about fundraising. Although I expected to take a short sabbatical from museums, I fell in love with EWU and stayed.

I have since served as director of philanthropy for two colleges,

EWU Libraries and as director of gift planning. I have been in the AVP role directing the campaign since 2021. I became an Eagle4Life in 2019, earning a Master of Science in Communication (MSC) degree and I teach a fundraising course for EWU's communication studies department.

University Advancement is an exceptional team collaborating to move the needle in meaningful ways for the university. We are driving momentum for our Build Our Future campaign goals. The new fundraising year began on July 1. During fiscal year 2025, we raised \$10,943,357. The current campaign total is \$76,927,472 (toward the goal of \$100,000,000). This first-ever comprehensive campaign for Eastern had an initial target of \$65 million for the 10-year campaign. We surpassed that goal in year seven. The campaign ends on June 30, 2027.

Thank you for your participation, support and dedication to Eastern Washington University. Together, we are making a difference.




Fundraising Focus
