Preferred:

M.A. in History
Ph.D. in History

Equivalencies:

M.A. in closely-related fields (Government, American Studies, English, Anthropology, Social Studies ED., etc.) and Ph.D. in closely-related fields

Notes:

The History Program takes a holistic approach to evaluating CEP instructor candidates. While an M.A. in History is the preferred qualification, many of our instructors hold some set of equivalencies.
