The Carney brothers borrowed \$600 from their mom. The name Pizza Hut came about because their sign could only hold 8 characters!

Pizza Hut pioneered the Book It program that allowed elementary students to earn pizza by reading books. They were also the first to allow customers to order pizza online, stuffed crust, deliver pizza to the Space Station, the first major pizza chain to be on Facebook, allow gamers to order pizza through their Xbox 360, deliver to Mt.
