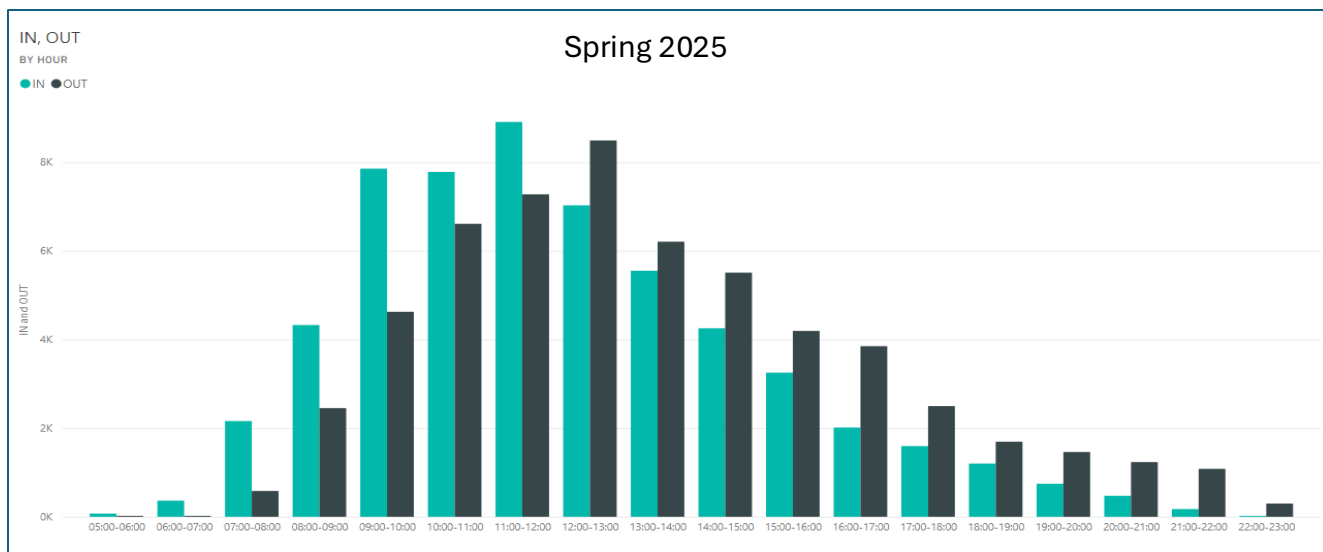
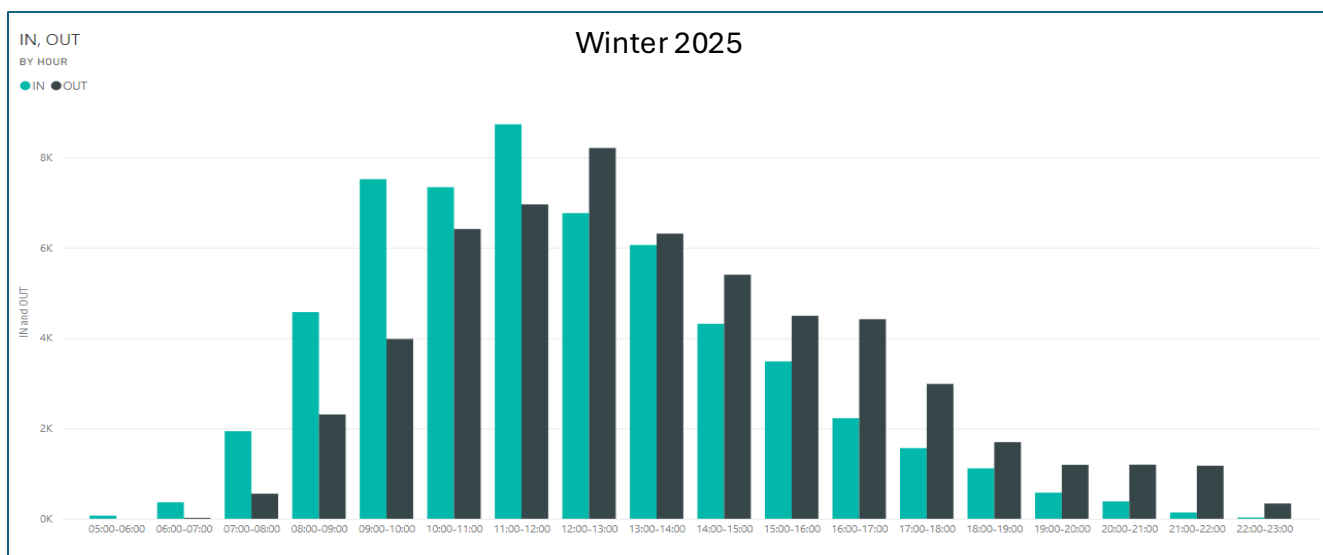
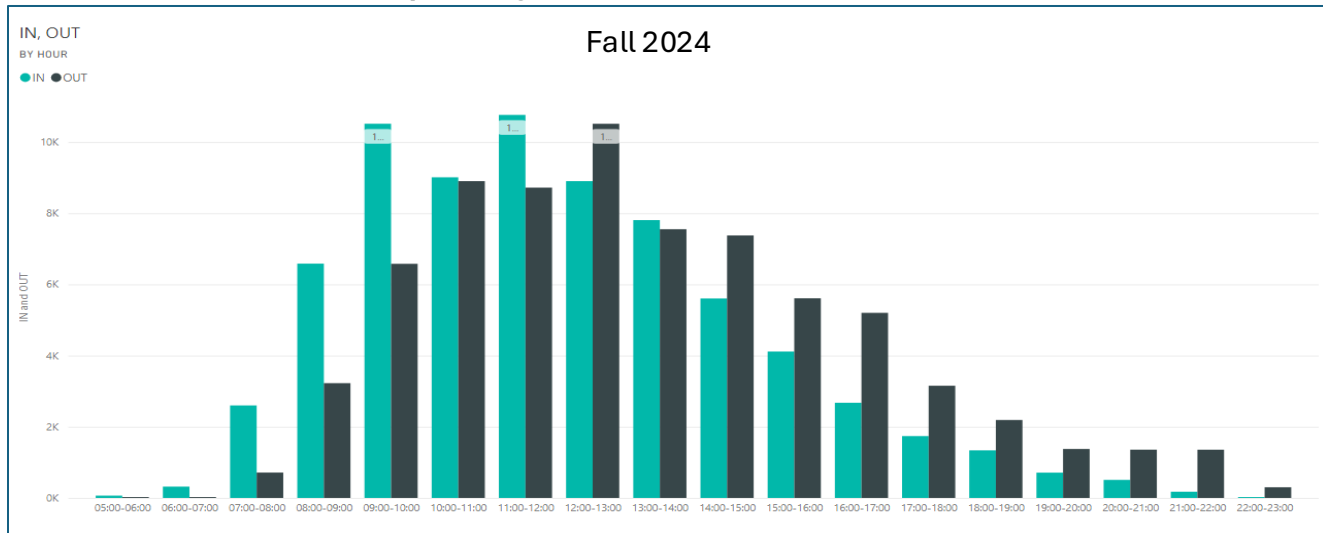

EWU Libraries 2024-2025 – Gate Count Trends

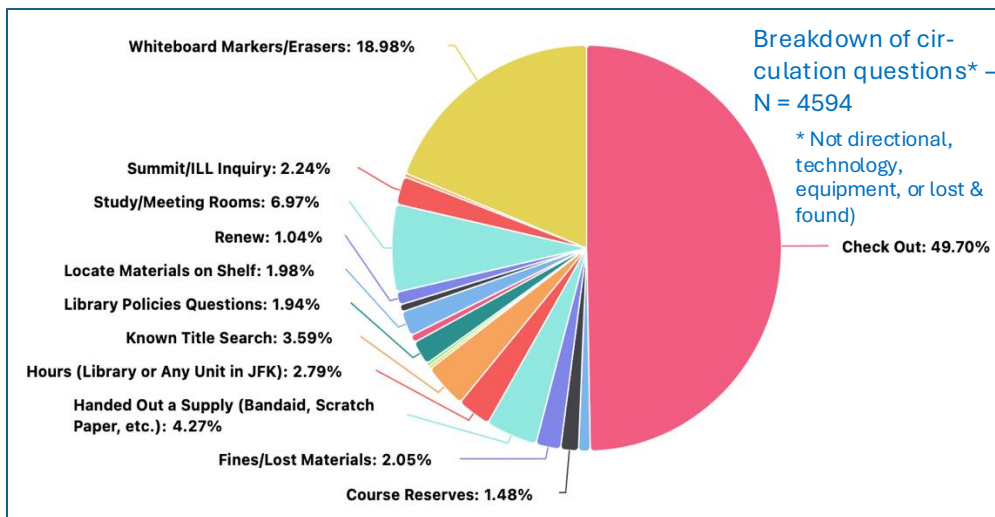


EWU Libraries 2024-2025 – Main Service Desks Details

At the **Circulation Desk**, we provided assistance **5,976** times.

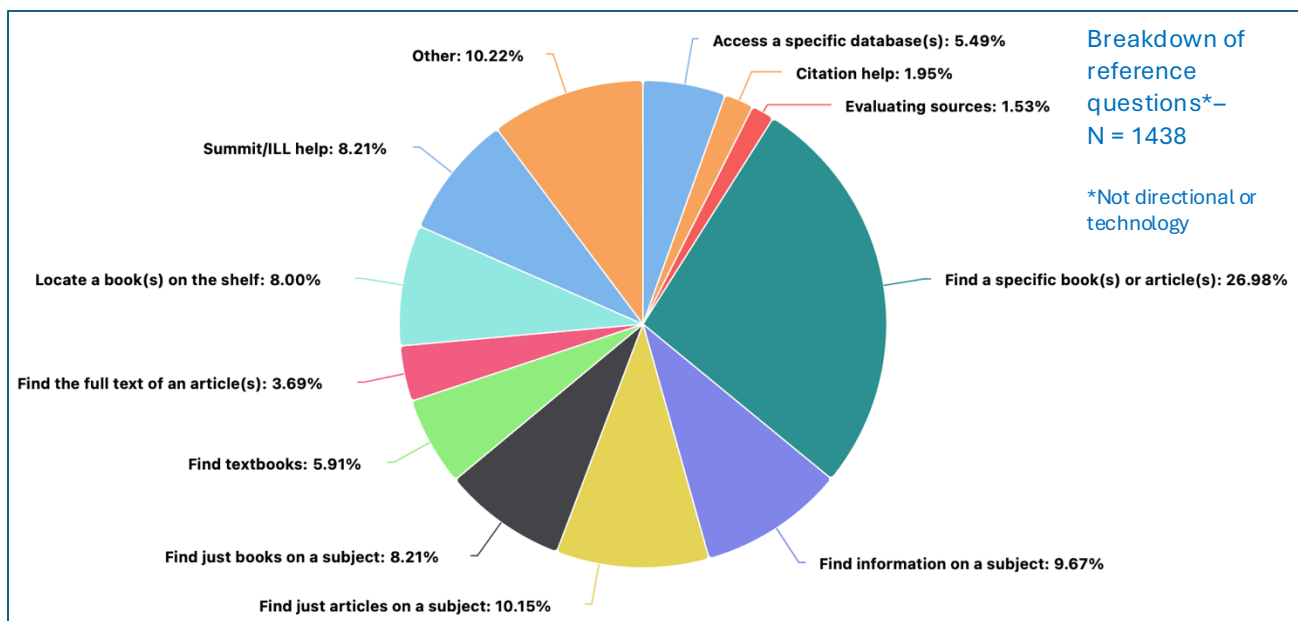
- 89.3% were students

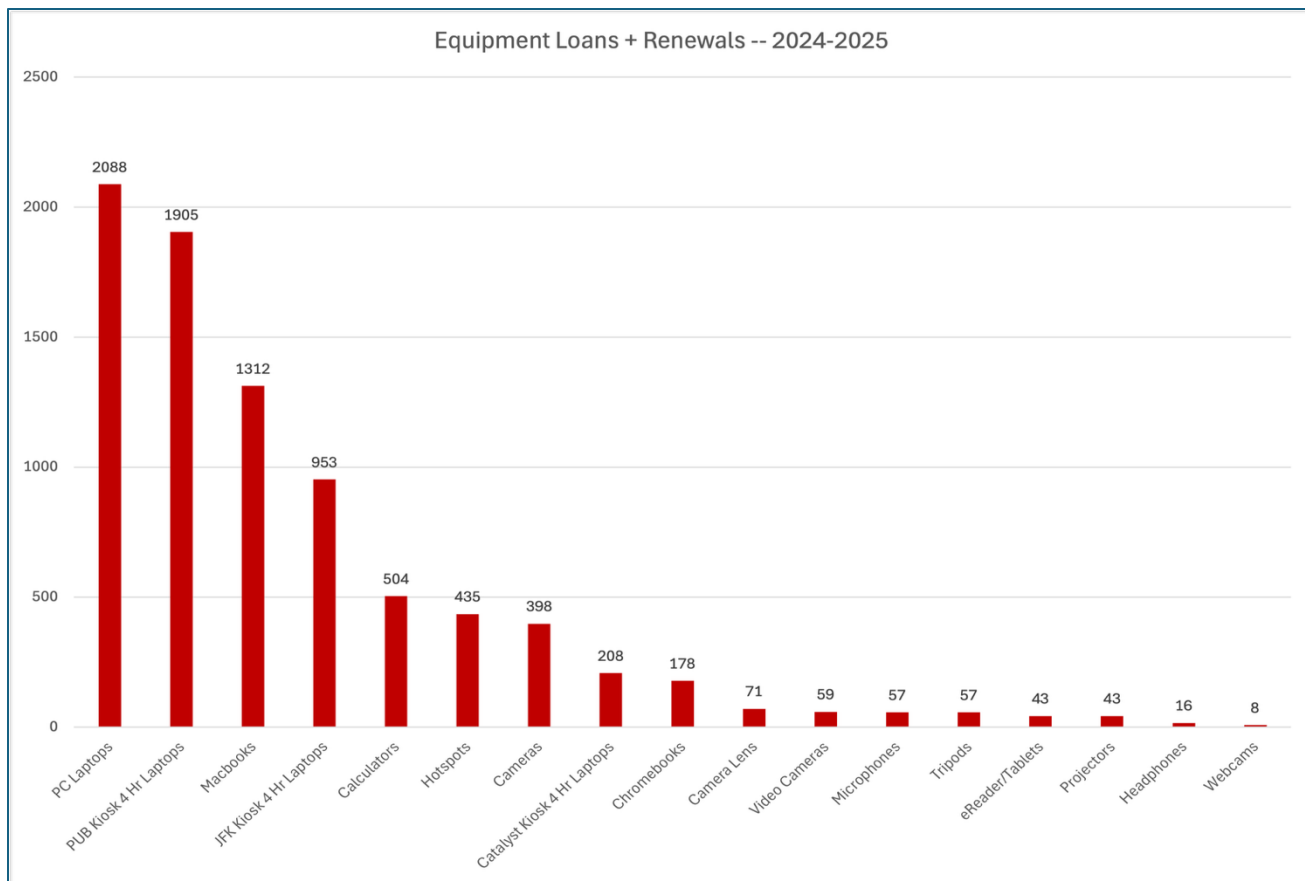
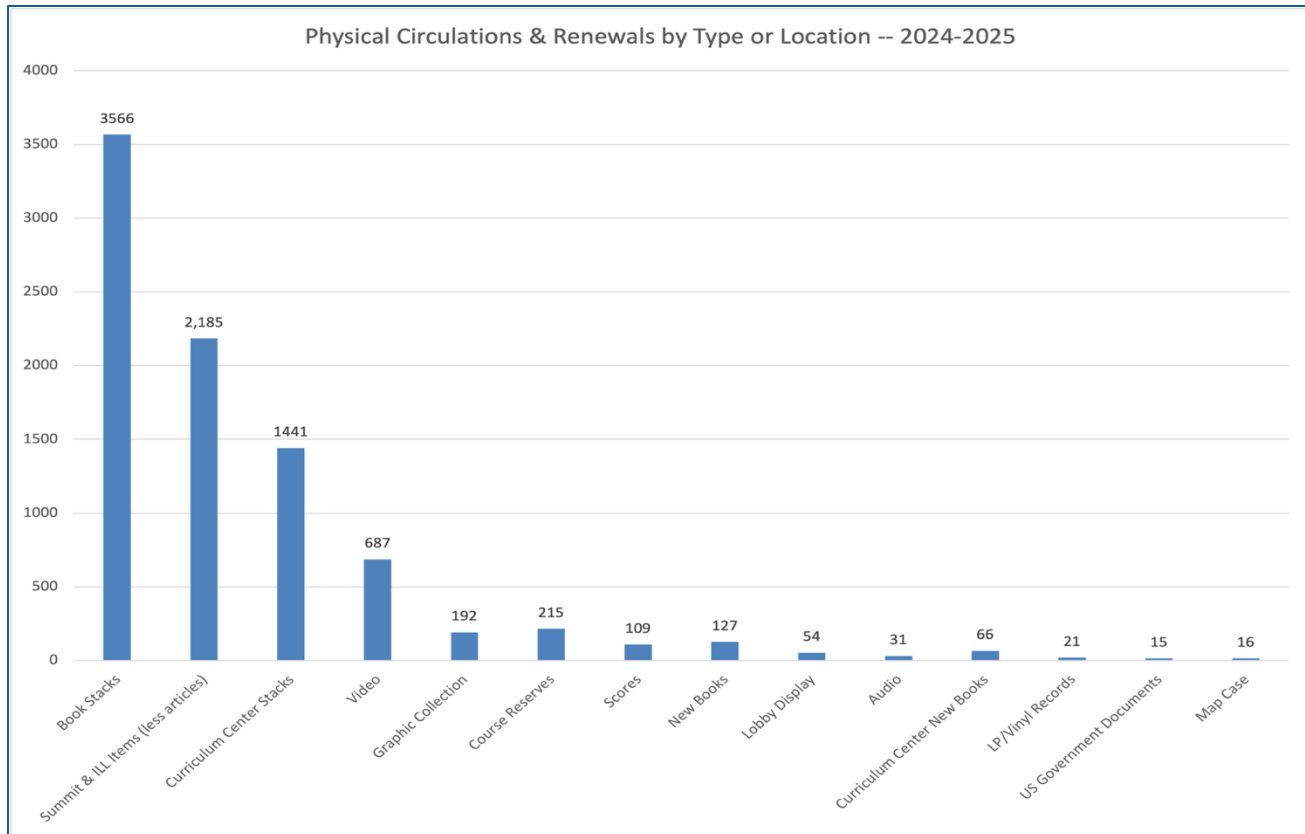

EWU Libraries 2024-2025 – Instruction Details

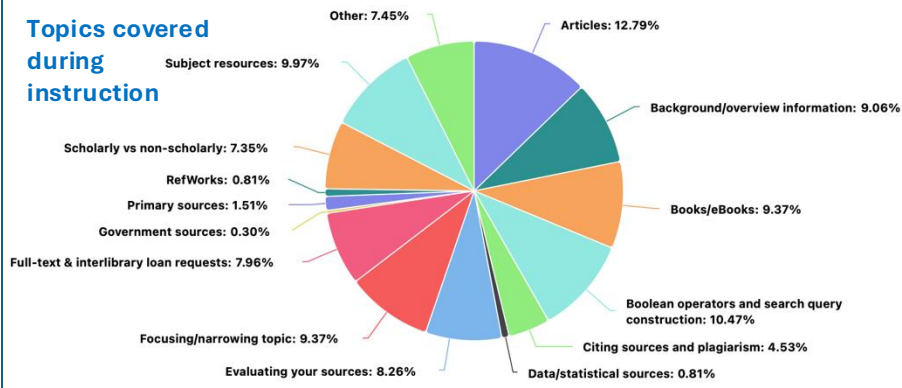
Library faculty taught 328 sessions.

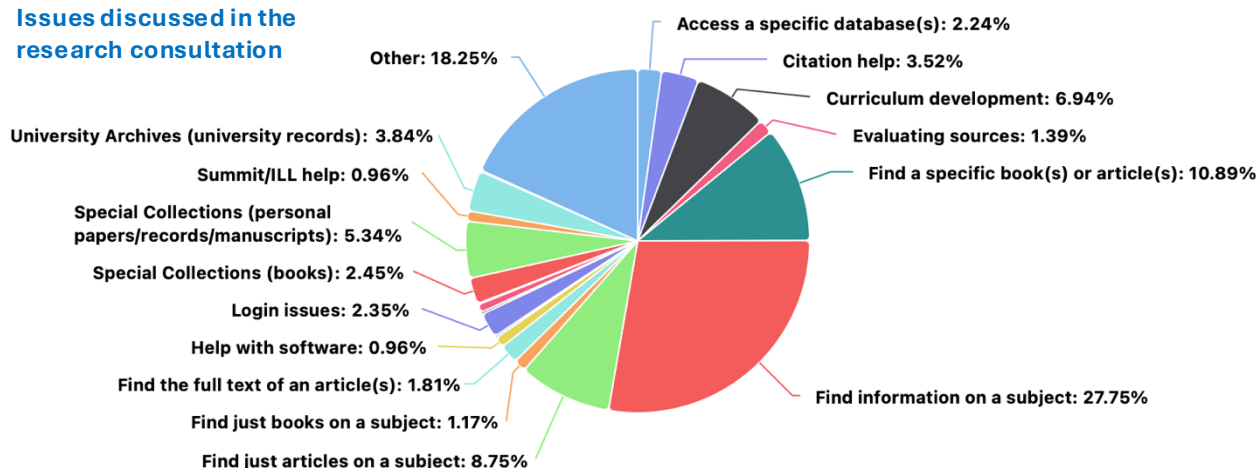
Library faculty held **805** research consultations or helped individuals via email, phone or chat.

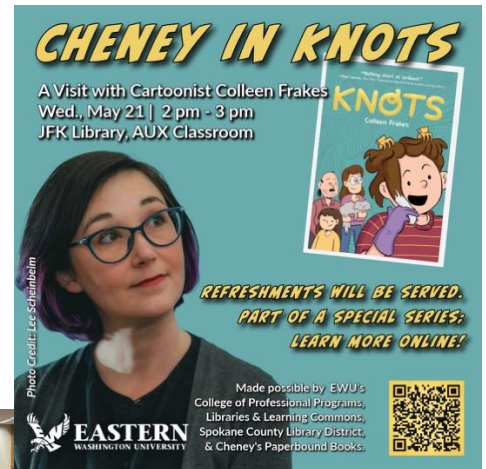
EWU Libraries 2024-2025 – Events
